RRCA State Rep vacancy in Kentucky

I am currently seeking a qualified individual to fill a Road Runners Club of America (RRCA) State Rep vacancy in Kentucky. The State Rep acts as a liaison between the RRCA National Office and the running clubs in the state.

The person I am looking for doesn't have to be a fast runner, but it would be a plus if he/she has some experience with club and/or race management. The State Rep position is nonpaid, i.e. a volunteer job, but offers a few "perks" such as subsidized travel to the Annual RRCA Conventions. It is also a wonderful opportunity to stay involved in the running community, learn a few new things, and last but not the least to make some new friends!

Here is a brief summary of the expectations of a State Rep:

- ***Attend the Annual RRCA Convention, and participate in State Rep training there.*** (2010 in Lakeland, FL, April 21-25, 2011 in Fredericksburg, VA, May 12-15).
- ***Award and hold RRCA State Championships.*** Races will bid for these and we recommend the State Rep travel to the Championships if possible.
- ***Email a newsletter to clubs on (at least) a quarterly basis.*** Format and content is up to the Rep, but we recommended that news about Championships and RRCA programs be included.
- ***Maintain a current list of Club Presidents in your State, and send them above newsletter and other communications.***
- ***Submit Annual and Semi-Annual Reports to Regional Director and National Office***

If you think you may be interested in this position yourself, or know someone else who might be, please let me know and we can chat some more. I can then give some more detail what is actually involved, and answer any questions that you (or the person) may have.
